Apply caution when you get New Year messages in your mail box! A massive attack of the Storm Worm variant called 'Zhelatin.pt' is underway with a rather simpler modus operandi, say Security Experts at MicroWorld Technologies...

It begins with emails arriving with subject line 'Happy New Year' or 'Message for new year'. The mail body has a web address

chosen from a random list that contains URLs like newyearcards2008.com, newyearwithlove.com, hohoho2008.com, hellosanta2008.com, happy2008toyou.com and uhavepostcard.com.(Please don't try to access any of these websites on your computer!)
